


CREATING / ACTIVATING YOUR MYUSNA ACCOUNT

The Naval Academy has transitioned to a new web-based platform. The Naval Academy Parents Club (NAPC) of Southern California (founded as Annapolis Parents Club of Southern California APCSC)) is migrating to the new USNA web-based platform. MyUSNA is a secure and private online forum to connect with Naval Academy Parent Groups, Classmates, Alumni Chapters, and Shared interest Groups (SIGs) while receiving USNA real-time news and upcoming events all in one place.


The Welcome Aboard Luncheon Reservations are in myUSNA. When you click on the link https://myusna.com/events/24846 to register, your browser will take you to myUSNA and you will see the screen below. These instructions will assist in creating your account.



When creating your account, required fields (marked with an asterisk) include First Name, Last Name, Email, and Affiliation. Under Affiliation, most will select Parent; if your relationship to the Academy is through a prep school or other, select Friend. Under Select what USNA Chapters, Parent's Club or other groups apply to you, select **NAPC of Southern California**. Once your account is created and validated by myUSNA (a separate email message sent from the Naval Academy), you'll be able to navigate to the reservation using the link





Your email address may already be in the myUSNA system (applicable to current and alumni parents). If that is the case, you will be prompted to reset your password after you have completed the other steps. This process is necessary to facilitate the End User License Agreement.



The request to join myUSNA may take up to one day (or the weekend) before a response is received from the U.S. Naval Academy. Once you can log in, you can access the link and purchase reservations to our Welcome Aboard Luncheon. Parent Club membership can also be purchased at the same time.
